• DPU Oil and Gas Pipeline Order

- o DPU released an order and press release
 - Phasing out new gas distribution from MA.
 - Working with municipalities

Inspectional Services Fees

- o Rick discussed with Sam Joslin (building inspector)
 - Committee to review fee schedule and make a proposal of changes.

Ideas discussed

- Construction fees:
 - Waive new construction fees for high efficiency homes
 - Waive electrical fees for new additions
 - EV charging stations
 - PV installations
- Water Heater:
 - o Eliminate fee for heat pump and solar

MassCEC Grant

- Applying for a grant to fund a consultant to help assess decarbonization upgrades of a non-profit or public service building over 20,000 sqft.
 - Building proposed is Town office building
 - Application to be completed
 - Consultants are pre-selected
 - Environmental justice communities (minority, income, English isolation) are prioritized
- Committee agrees to apply. Will need to inform the Select Committee of intention.
 Rick will call MassCEC to verify that the 1910 Building is eligible.

AOB

- Public meeting held on December 20th, DPU reversing course on municipal aggregation and other issues.
- Looking to be more flexible and less bureaucratic hassle, quicker review of applications.
- Next step for municipal aggregation in WN is to file for DOER review.
